Weight of trophy : measured with a 10 grams precision, 3 months after the trophy was cleaned, to allow drying. For evaluation in 1 to 8 days from cleaning, the following allowances will be applied to the raw weight:

- Trophies in between 4.00-6.00 kg: 0.30kg;
- Trophies in between 6.01-8.00 kg: 0.40 kg;
- Trophies in between 8.01-10.00 kg: 0.50 kg;
- Trophies bigger than 10.01 kg: 0.60 kg.
